Following the Sabbath Services there will be a Kiddush hosted by the Sisterhood.

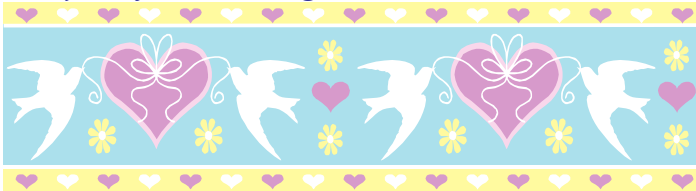

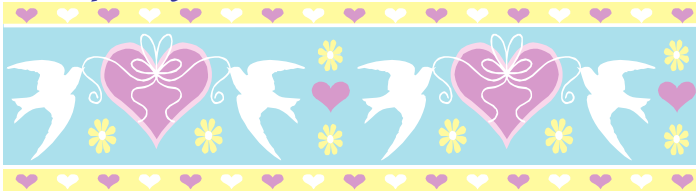

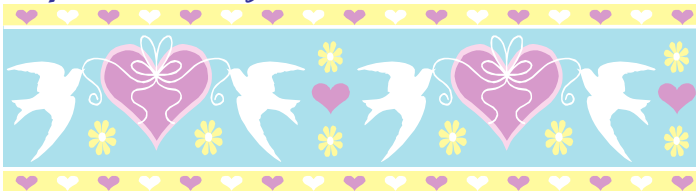
